- 2) This study is delimited to the teachers of Gujarati Medium.


Method of Research

In the present study, the researcher has selected primary school teachers for the cluster sampling. There were 100 primary school teachers in total of 4 school of Ahmedabad city as a sample.

From the above table, it is observed that the t-value 23.66 is more than $t_{0.01} = 2.58$. Thus the difference is significant and hence, the hypothesis may be rejected. Thus, the hypothesis that "There will be no significant difference between the man scores of the personality traits between male and female" will be rejected at 0.01 level. Further looking to the table, the mean of male teachers scores is 233.69 which is more than the mean score of female teachers 182.82. Thus, it is clear that the male teacher's having more personality traits than female teachers.

From the above table, it is observed that the t-value 2.09 is less than $t_{0.01} = 2.58$. Thus, the difference is significant 0.05 levels and hence the hypothesis is rejected. Thus, the hypothesis that "There will be no significant difference between the mean

scores of personality traits between east and west zone teachers” will be rejected. Further looking to the table, the mean score of east zone teachers are 137.1 is more than of mean score of west zone 129.8. Thus, it is clear that the east zone teacher having more personality traits than west zone teachers.

Findings

The researcher has presented the above findings after interpreting data, getting through the information according to the collected data which were as under:

- 1) There is a significant difference in personality traits of male and female teachers. Thus, it can be said that the male teacher’s having more personality traits than female teachers.
- 2) There is a significant difference in personality traits of teachers of east zone and west zone. Thus it can be said that the east zone teachers having more personality traits than west zone teachers.

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
